Events

Shotgun: Officers from the **Alabama Conservation Enforcement Officers Association (ACEOA)**, volunteers from the **Lower Wetumpka Shotgun Sports Club (LWSSC)**, and **NRA Certified** instructors from the **Small Arms Training Course (SAT-C)** will instruct in gun safety, techniques and terminology. Our team will teach you the skills need to have you shooting like Annie Oakley! Get ready to PULL! Practice makes perfect! Learn shooting techniques that will advance your skills You will be ready to participate in the **OWU No Limits Shooting Event** in the spring.

Archery: As one of the most popular outdoor activities, archery is a sport of skill and precision. Our instructors will teach you a fool proof formula for hitting the bulls eye every time.

First Aid/Compass/Orienteering: Two of the most important skills to know if you do any outdoor adventures. . . How to navigate and how to take care of yourself and others. Our professional instructors will teach you the basic skills needed for first aid and navigation in the woods.

Self Defense & Hatchet Throwing: Become a graduate of the academy of self defense. **Bill Page owner of the Martial Arts Center of Montgomery, Alabama** will teach you the skills and information you need to protect yourself against any intruder. Teaching the basic safety and essential elements of proper fire. Our certified instructors will be on hand to introduce the basic safety, components, and use of air rifles.
