Sporting Clays

Each team of four or five shooters will shoot 50 clays on the GSO sporting clays course. Prizes will be given to the HOA male, HOA female, and HOA child. Games will also be available in the morning and prizes will be awarded to the highest place in each game for male, female, and child.

Dove Shoot

Shooters will be placed in the dove field in the afternoon. Maximum bird per hunter is 15 and each shooter will be dropped off and picked up by OWU and GSO staff.

GRAND PRIZE

Great Southern Outdoors Hunt will be given to the female with the largest amount of dove harvested in the field during the hunt.
